This guide shows some flowers you can grow with us. While these are popular seasonal choices, you can explore others too! Each flower includes growth time, benefits, and difficulty, and we manage your plot so you can enjoy beautiful blooms effortlessly.

Spring:

Tulips

- Growth Time: 8–16 weeks
- Benefits: Brightens gardens, popular cut flower, low maintenance
- Difficulty: Easy

Daffodils

- Growth Time: 8–12 weeks
- Benefits: Adds spring color, deer-resistant, low maintenance
- Difficulty: Easy

Hyacinths

- Growth Time: 10–14 weeks
- Benefits: Fragrant, vibrant spring color, good for borders
- Difficulty: Moderate

Crocus

- Growth Time: 6–10 weeks
- Benefits: Early spring bloom, low maintenance, attracts pollinators
- Difficulty: Easy

Pansies

- Growth Time: 6–8 weeks
- Benefits: Long-lasting blooms, versatile in containers and beds

- Difficulty: Easy

Primrose

- Growth Time: 8–12 weeks
- Benefits: Early spring color, hardy in cool climates, attracts pollinators
- Difficulty: Moderate

Ranunculus

- Growth Time: 10–14 weeks
- Benefits: Bright, layered blooms, popular for bouquets
- Difficulty: Moderate



Summer:

Sunflowers

- Growth Time: 70–100 days
- Benefits: Bright, cheerful blooms; attracts pollinators; seeds edible
- Difficulty: Easy

Zinnias

- Growth Time: 50–70 days
- Benefits: Long-lasting blooms; vibrant colors; attracts butterflies
- Difficulty: Easy

Marigolds

- Growth Time: 45–60 days
- Benefits: Pest-repelling properties; bright summer blooms; low maintenance
- Difficulty: Easy

Cosmos

- Growth Time: 60–90 days
- Benefits: Attracts pollinators; long blooming season; drought-tolerant
- Difficulty: Easy

Petunias

- Growth Time: 70–90 days
- Benefits: Vibrant flowers for beds and containers; long-lasting blooms
- Difficulty: Easy

Lavender

- Growth Time: 90–120 days
- Benefits: Fragrant; attracts pollinators; can be used for culinary and crafts
- Difficulty: Moderate

Snapdragons

- Growth Time: 70–90 days
 - Benefits: Vertical blooms; attracts pollinators; adds texture to flower beds
 - Difficulty: Moderate

Fall:

Chrysanthemums

- Growth Time: 90–120 days
- Benefits: Long-lasting autumn blooms; vibrant colors; attracts pollinators
- Difficulty: Moderate

Asters

- Growth Time: 90–120 days
- Benefits: Late-season blooms; attracts butterflies and bees; low maintenance
- Difficulty: Easy

Marigolds

- Growth Time: 45–60 days
- Benefits: Pest-repelling properties; bright autumn color; easy to grow
- Difficulty: Easy

Pansies

- Growth Time: 60–75 days
- Benefits: Cold-tolerant; vibrant flowers; great for containers and beds
- Difficulty: Easy

Sedum

- Growth Time: 60–90 days
- Benefits: Drought-tolerant; late-season blooms; attracts pollinators
- Difficulty: Easy

Rudbeckia (Black-eyed Susan)

- Growth Time: 70–100 days
- Benefits: Bright yellow blooms; attracts pollinators; low maintenance

Calendula

- Growth Time: 50–70 days
 - Benefits: Edible petals; bright flowers; supports beneficial insects
 - Difficulty: Easy

Winter:

Amaryllis

- Growth Time: 90–120 days
- Benefits: Large, vibrant blooms; ideal for indoor winter display
- Difficulty: Moderate

Paperwhite Narcissus

- Growth Time: 60–90 days
- Benefits: Fragrant flowers; easy indoor forcing; brightens winter spaces
- Difficulty: Easy

Cyclamen

- Growth Time: 60–100 days
- Benefits: Long-lasting blooms; attractive foliage; indoor/outdoor adaptable
- Difficulty: Moderate

Camellia

- Growth Time: 180–240 days
- Benefits: Winter-blooming shrub; glossy evergreen leaves; ornamental value
- Difficulty: Moderate

Poinsettia

- Growth Time: 90–120 days
- Benefits: Iconic holiday plant; vibrant red bracts; indoor decoration

- Difficulty: Easy

Hellebore (Christmas Rose)

- Growth Time: 120–150 days
- Benefits: Early winter blooms; evergreen foliage; shade-tolerant
- Difficulty: Moderate
